

Dear Parent,

While school is closed, your child should use Lexia® Core5® Reading at home. Core5 is a fun, computer-based program that has helped millions of students improve their literacy skills. The activities in Core5 support and build on your child's classroom curriculum and focus on developing reading skills in six areas: phonological awareness, phonics, structural analysis, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.

Here's how Lexia Core5 Reading works:

- Your child begins Core5 at a starting point that fits his or her needs.
- Online activities include direct instruction and immediate feedback as your child learns new skills.
- Progress and performance in the online activities is saved and available for teacher review.

While school is closed, you should support progress in the program by reading daily with your child and talking about what you have read. Students in Y7 and Y8 have been provided with two books to read at home. However, their reading does not need to be limited to books. They can read online, recipes, information on food packets, etc.

Using Lexia Core5 Reading at home. Getting started is easy!

1. To use on a computer, go to www.lexiacore5.com.
2. To use on an iPad, download the free Lexia Core5 Reading app from the App Store. (iPad support is limited to these devices: iPad 4+, iPad Mini 3+, iPad Air+, and iPad Pro.)
3. The first time your child uses Core5 at home, you may need to help them set it up by entering the teacher email shown below. Your child can then log in with the username and password that is shown below.
4. Most students will then complete an online assessment. It is important that your child works independently on this as the program will then provide ongoing work at an appropriate level for your child. They should always use the program independently.
5. Your child should spend 20 to 30 minutes per weekday (Monday-Friday) using Core5 at home during the school closure including during the Easter holidays. The assessment may take longer than 20-30 minutes.
