Riff – short repeated pattern

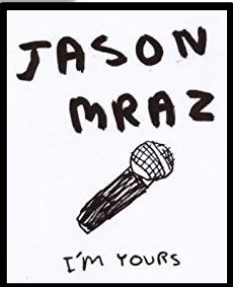
Drum fill – a short break that 'fills' in the gaps
