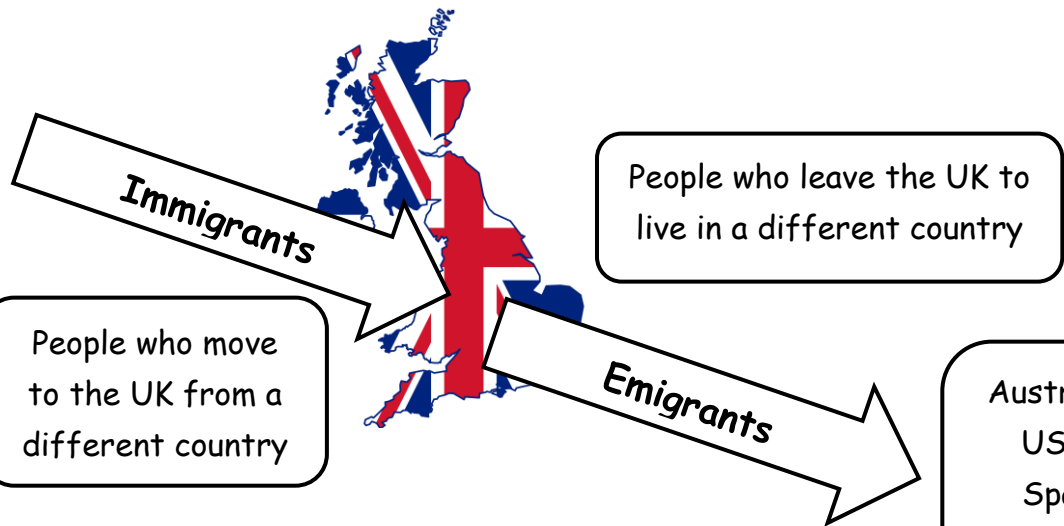
**Citizen:**

and  
at least 1 parent is a UK citizen

Born in a UK overseas territory  
and  
at least 1 parent is a UK citizen

Applied to become a British citizen  
(naturalisation including a test)

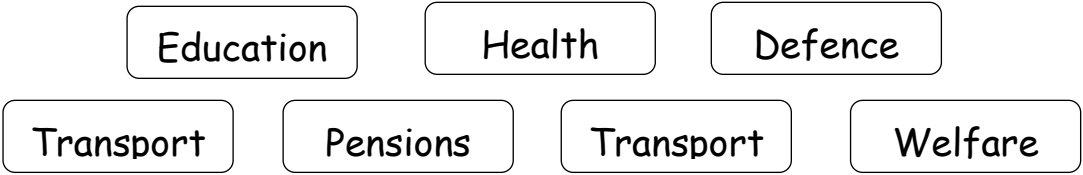
