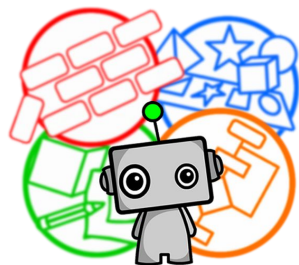
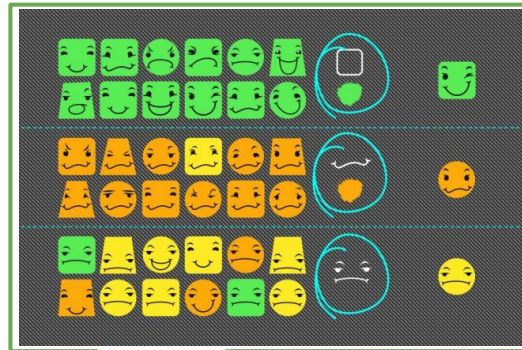
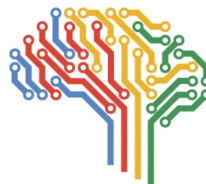
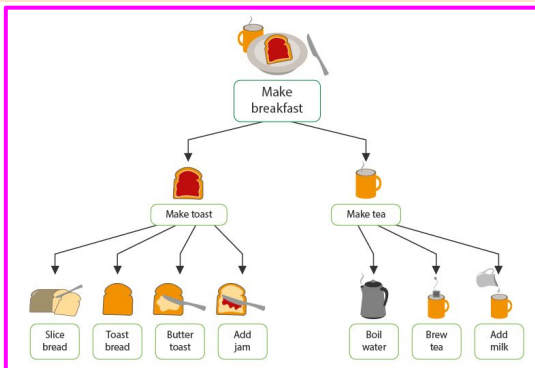


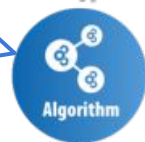
Key Vocabulary

Pattern Recognition	Looking for similarities between and within problems.



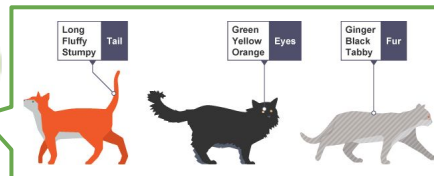
