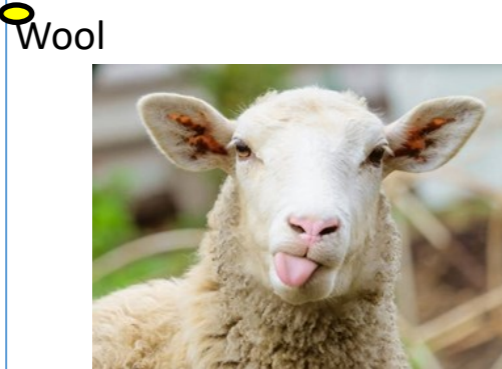


# Knowledge organiser: Year 7 Textiles

## Key words & Definitions

1	<b>Applique</b>	When you attach another piece of fabric to another piece. Either by hand or by machines.
2	<b>Fastenings</b>	Fastenings are a way of opening and closing a section of a product. Fastenings can sometimes be called components.
3	<b>Fibres</b>	A fibre is a hair-like substance. Fibres can be spun and woven together into fabric.
4	<b>Fabrics</b>	Fabric is cloth made from natural or synthetic fibres.
5	<b>Yarns</b>	A yarn is a thread made from twisted fibres and is used for weaving, knitting, sewing and embroidery.
6	<b>Fabric Properties</b>	Properties are the distinguishing features of a material.



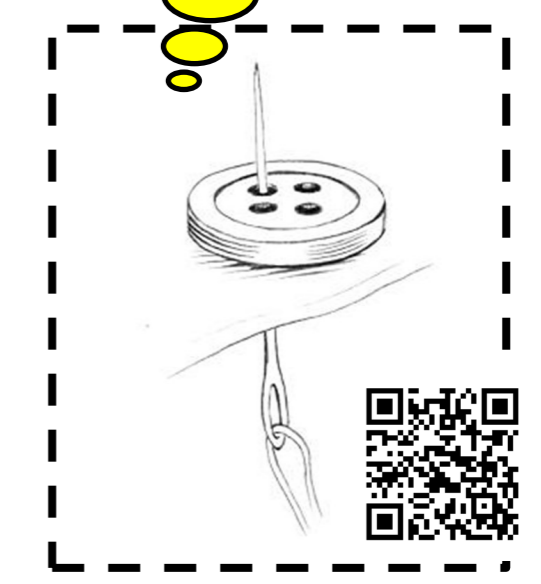
Natural fibres come from either plants or animals.
