At The Nottingham Emmanuel School we value the opinions of our students to help us improve the quality of our lessons. From Monday 6 to Friday 10 December we will be holding a 'Make your voice heard' week.

Every student will be emailed a link to a simple online questionnaire about their different subjects. They can find this link by logging into their school email account. They need to click on this link to access a bank of statements (see below).

My lessons include a spaced retrieval task to connect to prior learning.
My teachers make sure I work hard in all lessons.
My teachers have high expectations of behaviour and effort.
My teachers ask questions to check I understand and help me when I don't understand.
My teachers look at my classwork/assessments and give me written or verbal feedback to improve my work.
My lessons are engaging and I am learning a lot.
Word walls are used in lessons for new vocabulary.
My teacher talks about the strategies that I can use when reading

For each of their subjects, all they have to do is click on the number of stars to reflect how strongly they feel about each of the statements. It is important that they do this for each of the subjects on the timetable so that we get a wide range of responses.

We appreciate that this will take time to complete and therefore one of your child's homework tasks next week will be replaced with the questionnaire to enable them to have time to think and feed back to us. Please do encourage your child to complete the questionnaire and ask them to look out for the task which will be set on Teams.

As a little bit of extra encouragement, we will be holding a prize draw and every child who completes the questionnaire will have their name put into a hat to win one of three £20 vouchers per year group. A very nice early Christmas treat!
